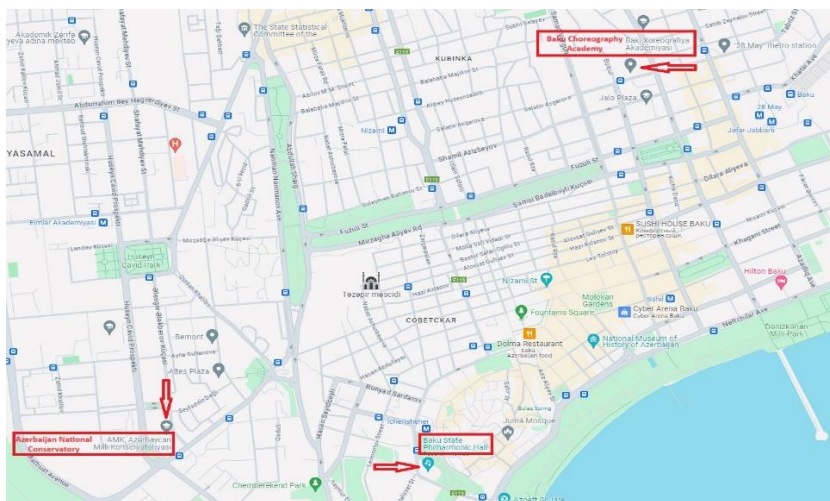

Venues

The Joint Symposium of the ICTMD Study Groups on Music and Dance in the Turkic World and Global History of Music "Echoes of Heritage: Navigating the Legacy of Music and Dance" (hereinafter referred to as **the Joint Symposium**) will be held in Baku, Azerbaijan, from September 18 to 22, 2024, with sessions hosted at the Azerbaijan National Conservatory and the Baku Choreography Academy. The majority of the symposium's sessions will convene in **the Azerbaijan National Conservatory's Amirov Hall, Baku Hall, and Karabakh Hall**. Sessions dedicated to dance-related topics will be held at **the Baku Choreography Academy**.

In conjunction with the symposium, participants are also invited to attend the **XVI Uzeyir Hajibeyli International Music Festival**, taking place at the **Muslim Magomayev Azerbaijan State Academic Philharmonic Hall**. Attendees can enjoy the festival's performances each evening following the symposium sessions.



Guide for Participants at the Joint Symposium

Below are the guidelines for the Programme. Please read them carefully taking note of the times allotted, speakers / presenters and chairs, for in-person and online formats. The list of poster presenters is provided at the end of the programme.

Session Timing

The Joint Symposium consists of plenary sessions, workshops, panel discussions featuring three or four individual or joint papers, book presentations, and poster presentations. Some sessions may feature only two papers.

- **Plenary Sessions & Workshops:** 40 minutes
- **Panel Sessions:** Each paper is allotted 20 minutes for presentation, followed by 10 minutes for questions and discussion.
- **Book Presentations:** 30 minutes

Role of Session Chairs

The Chair plays a crucial role in fostering intellectual discourse and ensuring the smooth operation of the session. Chairs should:

1. Briefly introduce themselves and welcome participants.
2. Remind presenters of their allotted time.
3. Announce each presenter's full name(s), affiliation(s), and paper title.
4. Encourage questions, discussion, and interaction with the audience following each presentation.
5. Ensure that the session adheres strictly to the schedule and finishes on time.

If a panel presenter does not show up, the Chair must still adhere to the original schedule, waiting until the allotted time for the next paper to begin.

Programme of the Joint Symposium

Each session in the programme is assigned a unique identifier consisting of three components:

1. **Roman Numeral:** Indicates the day of the conference (I-V).
2. **Capital Letter:** Denotes the session or event.
3. **Arabic Numeral:** Identifies parallel sessions.

For example, the identifier “IIC03” refers to the third parallel session on the second day of the conference, within session C.

The Joint Symposium features four main thematic directions:

- **Prominent Personalities in the History of Music and Dance Heritage**
- **Shusha Musical Heritage in the Context of the Dialogue of Cultures**
- **Legacy, Preservation, and Change of Music and Dance Traditions**
- **Music Therapy: Problems and Perspectives in the 21st Century**

These themes are further divided into sub-sections, distinguished by lowercase Latin letters (a, b, c, d) and followed by Arabic numerals if a sub-section is divided into smaller groups of 3-4 presenters (e.g., a01, b03, c03).

Session venue is indicated in square brackets following the session title. The name of the session Chair is listed after the sub-section title.
